



Wedding Booking Terms & Conditions

AGREEMENT

The Wedding Booking Form and this Agreement contain the entire understanding between Keith Osborn Photography and the Client or the people getting married if different (referred to as the Client in the rest of this Agreement). It replaces any prior agreements.

BOOKING DEPOSIT, PAYMENT AND CONFIRMATION

The agreed deposit is due on signing this agreement (usually 50% of the final fee), with the balance due 6 weeks before the day of the wedding. If the wedding is cancelled, the booking deposit is non-refundable. The services of Keith Osborn Photography are only confirmed once a completed Wedding Booking Form, a signed Wedding Agreement and the agreed deposit have been received.

PRE-WEDDING CONSULTATION(S)

The initial consultation normally happens at the time of booking. The Client will outline what is required and Keith Osborn Photography will advise on planning, logistics and timings. If required, further meetings can be arranged to agree the remaining details. In any case we will contact you a few weeks before the wedding to ensure that there have been no last minute changes.

CO-OPERATION

The Client and Keith Osborn Photography consent to cheerfully co-operate and communicate to achieve the best result within the understanding of this Agreement, for example by giving the photographer a helper (e.g. the Best Man) to organise people for the photos. The Client agrees to give sufficient warning of key events at the wedding (e.g. bouquet throwing, cutting the cake, speeches). The Client agrees to give the photographer precedence over guests' photographs in order to take the photographs required for the wedding services agreed. We cannot be held liable if guests prevent the photographer from taking the agreed photos. If any guests do not want their photo taken, the photographer cannot be held responsible for a lack of photos of these people.

THE SCHEDULE

Our shooting schedule, style of working and experience are designed to achieve a great set of wedding photos. Keith Osborn Photography and the Client agree that punctuality and cheerful co-operation are essential. If the wedding does not run on time (for example, if the Bride arrives late) we cannot guarantee to take our normal set of photos, although we will do our best to do so.

HOUSE RULES

The photographer is sometimes limited by rules imposed by registrars, ministers and venues as to what can and cannot be done. For example flash photography may not be allowed, or the photographer may be asked to shoot from a specific location. The Client agrees to accept such limitations, should become aware of the rules and if necessary negotiate with the personnel concerned.

COPYRIGHT LAW

English copyright law states that the copyright of photographs remains with the photographer. Digital images provided are for personal use by the Client and their friends and relatives, and may not be reproduced for commercial gain.

MODEL RELEASE

The Client grants Keith Osborn Photography and its legal representatives, heirs and assigns, the irrevocable and unlimited consent to use the photographs for any purpose and in any manner, and to alter the photographs without restriction. The Client releases Keith Osborn Photography and its legal representatives, heirs and assigns from all liability and claims in connection with the images.

LIMIT OF LIABILITY

If Keith Osborn Photography cannot supply the services due to illness or injury, we will try to book a replacement photographer. If one cannot be found then liability is limited to a refund of any payments received. If images are lost, stolen or destroyed for reasons in or beyond our control, liability is limited to the return of fees paid according to the percentage of images supplied.
